Questions submitted by potential offerors and answers from the state:

Question 1: 1.(5.01A Vessel Performance Standards) "Vessel must pass a stability test per USCG requirements"
Can you provide more details on which USCG requirements we would need to comply with?

Answer: The requirements are those expected for vessels of similar design and use.

Question 2: (5.01B) "It must have a soft nose, non-metal bow." Is a padded bow cover over a metal nose cone acceptable?

Answer: Yes, this is acceptable.

Question 3: (5.01C) Yamaha has discontinued the XTO 425 and now only offers the XTO 450. Note that while the 425's are advertised on the Yamaha website, our Yamaha OEM reps have confirmed they are clearing the rest of their 425 inventory.

Answer: Yes, the 450 is acceptable due to discontinuation of the 425.

Question 4: (5.01C Fresh Water Systems) "All water pipes to be insulated accordingly" Can you provide additional explanation for this requirement? Is it only water pipes external of the heated/insulated cabin?

Answer: This is only required if piping is ran in a manner or location that would require insulation.

Question 5: (5.01C House Distribution System) "House power batteries shall be charged with a consta-volt battery charger" Is consta-volt a specific model/brand? Can DPS provide more detail.

Answer: Constavolt is a specific product, but other similar chargers are acceptable.

Question 6: (5.01D Accommodations) "Accommodation of this vessel shall comfortably accommodate the needs of two people minimum while on patrol for 2-7 days." Does this requirement mean that it has to supply food and water for 7 days? Or are they patrolling areas where they can resupply every few days? 20 gallons would not be enough water. What size of fridge is required?

Answer: No it does not have to have the ability to hold food and water for 7-days. Patrols are in areas where resupplying can occur, along with getting freshwater. Refrigerators located on similar size vessels have had 1.7-2 cubic feet units, this vessel we would like approximately 4-5 cubic feet.

Question 7: (5.01M Quality of Vessel Design) "The design submitted by each offering contractor must contain the following minimum information: 4. Structural plans for hull describing: plate stiffeners, frames, girders, and bulkheads" Would a 3D rendering with callouts showing primary hull scantlings be acceptable?

Answer: Yes, this would be acceptable.

Changes to the RFP:

Change 1: (5.01C Fuel System) "Tank to have sediment/water collection sumps with drains" is removed from the solicitation.
