NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC AND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION LAS 35210 ALASKA SPORTSMAN'S LODGE, LLC

Subject to AS 38.05.850, the Southcentral Regional Land Office has received an application for the following:

APPLICANT: ALASKA SPORTSMAN'S LODGE, LLC

PROJECT NAME: LAS 35210

GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION: In the tidal flats near the mouth of the Douglas River in the southwestern portion of Kamishak Bay, in the Kamishak Special Use Area near Katmai National Park and Preserve.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: NE1/4 Section 9, Township 13 South, Range 27 West, Seward Meridian

REQUESTED ACTIVITY: The applicant, Alaska Sportsman's Lodge, is requesting a 5-year Land Use Permit for the seasonal (June through October) placement and use of one mooring buoy and anchor for two 18' skiffs within the tidal flats of Kamishak Bay in support of guided day-trips. The anchor system would be removed at the end of each season and skiffs moved back to the permitted site near the mouth of Kamishak River.

PROPOSED DATES OF USE:

Start: September 1, 2024 End: October 31, 2026

DEADLINE FOR COMMENTS: August 30, 2024

The public is invited to comment on this activity. The purpose of this notice is to gather input before a decision is made on this activity. To ensure consideration, written comments must be received by the Division of Mining, Land and Water at the Southcentral Regional Land Office, 550 W. 7th Ave., Suite 900C, Anchorage, AK 99501-3577 on or before 5:00 PM on the date noted above.
