QUESTIONS SUBMITTED BY OFFERORS AND ANSWER FROM THE STATE

- <u>Question 1</u>: Provide details and scope of work pertaining to clearing / grubbing / site work / foundation?
- Answer 1: No Foundation work will be needed. Surface pilings are to be used to support housing units. Ground is cleared of trees, brush and debris. Organic layer may need to be removed for pilings to rest firmly on soil.
- Question 2: Is there a driveway and gravel pad in place for each?
- Answer 2: There is not an individual driveway or gravel pad for each housing unit. The space for the units is accessible for vehicles and equipment. The housing units will be situated in a wooded area that has been cleared of trees, brush and debris.
- <u>Question 3</u>: SEC 2.08 says work is to be performed at Milepost 123.9 Glenn Highway but then also states that workspace will not be provided. Can we assemble the tiny homes offsite and then deliver to the project site
- Answer 3: The only space provided will be the final location of the housing units. Additional space will not be provided on site to build, assemble, or prefabricate any portion of the units. Housing units may also be built or prefabricated off site and delivered to the project site whole or for assembly.
- Question 4: Any clearing and grubbing requirements?
- Answer 4: Area and ground are cleared of trees, brush and debris. Organic layer may need to be removed for pilings to rest firmly on soil.

CHANGES TO THE ITB

Change 1: Section 2.10 "Scope of Work and Specifications" has had the following updates:

- Roof will have a minimum of 4' eve on front and 2' eve on back of unit.
- Two (2) windows will be installed in each unit, each with a minimum size of 3ft by 3ft.
