#### Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Board of Massage Therapists against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Board of Massage Therapists after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations concern cardiopulmonary resuscitation certification and courses required for massage therapist licensure. The regulations clarify that courses that adhere to the most recent American Heart Association guidelines and courses that are compliant with current Joint Commission standards are accepted by the board for certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

The August 7, 2024 public notice and the September 9, 2024 certification of adoption both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

No technical corrections were necessary to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060.
