## BETHEL HOUSING COMPLEX

### **Introduction:**

The State of Alaska, Department of Law is seeking information about parcels of land in Bethel, AK that would be suitable to build a State Housing Complex to provide quality living spaces for State of Alaska employees and their families. Total size will be a minimum of 3.5 acres of land, enough to construct ten housing units of approximately .33 acres each. If plots are smaller than the total need, multiple plots must be sharing a border with the rest of the Complex parcels.

### **Response Information:**

**Interested parties are invited to submit responses to the following:**

1. Provide a general description of your land and location and a copy of the plat.
2. Potential market value of the land based on last appraisal.
3. Describe your ownership and the timing of a possible sale.
