Igiugig Water/Sewer Project AN 92-686, Class A Public Water System

Dear Mr. Crownholm:

On June 23, 2005 this office received ANTHC's submittal addressing the conditions for final approval to operate listed in my May 31, 2005 letter. The following was included in your submittal:

- 1. Calculations showing the water system has sufficient capacity to meet peak system demand while maintaining at least 20 psi service pressure.
- 2. A statement specifying the water mains are constructed out of NSF 61 compliant HDPE pipe.
- 3. A waiver request for the 10-foot separation distance requirement between the water and sewer mains in three separate sections for a total of approximately 500 feet. The separation distance requirement for these three sections was not met due to limited space. The two 2-inch HDPE water distribution lines are encased within an insulated 6-inch arctic pipe. The sewer and water mains are buried in separate trenches and the water main is greater than 18 inches above the sewer main at all times. Based on this information, the waiver is granted.
- 4. Correspondence indicating a separation distance waiver was requested and granted for the lift station located 120 feet away from the well. Although correspondence specifically from ADEC granting the waiver cannot be found, it is apparent the waiver was granted and the lift station was constructed to be protective of public health based on the supplied documents and description of construction.

Based on the information submitted, final operational approval is granted.

Any person who disagrees with this decision may request an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 18 AAC 15.195-18 AAC 15.340 or an informal review by the Division Director in accordance with 18 AAC 15.185. Informal review requests must be delivered to the Division Director, 555 Cordova St., Anchorage, Alaska 99501, within 15 days of the permit decision. Adjudicatory hearing requests must be delivered to the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation.

410 Willoughby Avenue, Suite 303, Juneau, Alaska 99801, within 30 days of the permit decision. If a hearing is not requested within 30 days, the right to appeal is waived.
