Advisory committees are local groups that provide a local forum for the collection and expression of opinions and recommendations on matters related to the management of fish and wildlife resources. Meetings focus on developing and evaluating regulatory proposals and consulting with individuals, organizations, and agencies on fish, wildlife, and habitat issues. Members represent their communities before the Board of Fisheries and Board of Game at board meetings.

Meetings are open to the public. All residents of the area who are of legal voting age may make nominations and vote on committee membership.

The Northern Norton Sound has 15 seats; 6 seats from Nome, 1 seat from Wales, Elim, Teller, Brevig Mission, White Mountain, Golovin, and Shishmaref, and 2 undesignated seats. The topics discussed at the AC meets are brown bears, musk ox, chum/pink salmon, commercial fishing, and subsistence fishing.

To be eligible to make nominations or vote in an election: of a Fish & Game Advisory Committee, you must be a voting-age resident of the area served by the committee as defined in 5 AAC 96.910(10) and attending the election meeting. The areas served by the Northern Norton Sound Fish and Game Advisory Committee as defined in 5 AAC 97.005 are Game Management Units 22 and 23.
