Subject to AS 38.05.850, the Southcentral Regional Land Office has received an application for the following:

APPLICANT: KELLY GENE CLARK

PROJECT NAME: LAS 35215

GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION: State-owned land and submerged lands between applicant's private parcels, within a tributary of Big River; west of the Alaska Range.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: Section 14, Township 21 North, Range 29 West, Seward Meridian

REQUESTED ACTIVITY: The applicant, Kelly Clark, is requesting a one-year seasonal land use permit to repair the river banks of waters adjacent to his upland parcels per court ordered agreement to clean up the area. This includes leveling piles and removal of ramps via small garden tractor weighing 3,000 pounds. Applicant is also requesting to build a bridge nearby to connect his private parcels with a support in the middle using metal or plastic drums in 8'-12' of water.

PROPOSED DATES OF USE:

Start: June 1, 2025

End: September 30, 2025

DEADLINE FOR COMMENTS: December 5, 2024

The public is invited to comment on this activity. The purpose of this notice is to gather input before a decision is made on this activity.
