#### Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Environmental Conservation against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Department of Environmental Conservation after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations amend 18 AAC 70.010(d) to clarify the procedures the department will follow when establishing quality-based effluent limits for a water of the state that is not subject to the federal Clean Water Act and does not meet state water quality standards. Additionally, the procedures the department will follow for doing so are expanded to include the monitoring requirements for groundwater under 18 AAC 60.

The June 20, 2024 public notice and the December 5, 2024 adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

No technical corrections were necessary to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060.
