17. DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE

To reach the project site from Tom Madsen (Dutch Harbor) Unalaska Airport, follow Airport Drive east then turn left onto Airport Beach Road. Drive for approximately a quarter mile and turn left onto Ballyhoo Road. Continue down Ballyhoo Road for 0.76 miles. The UMC dock will be the first dock on the righthand side of Ballyhoo Road, waterward of the Latitude 54 building.

18. Nature of Activity (Description of project, include all features)

Screed face of UMC dock to a target elevation of -45.0', with a maximum overscreed depth of -47.0'. Material will not be lifted above water. New imported material will not exceed a total project quantity of 490 cubic yards (CY). Existing armor stone will be salvaged for reuse, if possible. The UMC dock shall maintain full capability during screeding operations.

19. Project Purpose (Describe the reason or purpose of the project, see instructions)

UMC dock provides Unalaska and surrounding remote communities with essential cargo, passenger, and port services. Current depth at MLLW measures 40 feet alongside the berthing area. This depth limits the draft of the vessels which can safely moor at the UMC dock. Screeding small quantities from the berthing area will expand dock capabilities by providing space for deeper draft vessels to access the dock.

Screeded material is planned to be pushed aside into designated disposal areas, screed material is not planned to be removed from the water.
