

## Notice of Proposed Native Allotment Substitution and Request to Relinquish

The records of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) indicate that Alaska Native allotment application serial no. F-17131 filed on March 29, 1972, by Peter C. Evans, is located on lands mistakenly conveyed to the State of Alaska (SOA), and the SOA has determined that it is not in the SOA's best interest to reconvey the original application lands. A potential substitute parcel of land for the application has been identified and is located on land in Federal ownership but selected by the SOA under Selection Application no. F-43741. The substitute parcel is located in Secs. 23 and 24, T. 11 N., R. 12 W., Fairbanks Meridian as depicted on the attached Master Title Plat (MTP).

In accordance with the Memorandum of Agreement dated July 28, 2013, and pursuant to AS 38.05.020(b)(8), the SOA may, in its discretion, voluntarily relinquish a portion of its unconveyed selection for the relocation of a parcel with an amended description when it is determined not to be in the SOA's best interest to reconvey the original application lands. Sec. 18 of ANCSA, 43 U.S.C. 1617(c), as amended, allows for the allotment applicant to amend the land description in the application to describe land other than the land that the applicant originally intended to claim if the original application conflicts with an interest in land granted to the SOA.

The BLM requests that the SOA indicate below if it will relinquish its application for the land included in the above-described substitute parcel. The number of acres to be relinquished will not exceed the number of acres of the original parcel being considered for relocation.
