The following inquiries are here presented and answered:

Question 1: Is this completed form to be submitted with our proposal?

Answer 1: No. The form, or questionnaire, referenced in RFP Section 3.05 – Intent to Propose and Non-Disclosure Agreement, is for reference only, to aid vendor in knowing what is expected of them and in determining level of effort. Note also that, per RFP Section 4.11, offerors must incorporate the security assessment into their proposed costs.

Question 2: Is the proposal due date still 11/20?

Answer: The deadline for receipt of proposals remains Wednesday, November 20, 2024. Note, however, the administrative correction above regarding the deadline for submission of questions.
