Question 1: Are you using a tracking service currently? If so, what are you using?

Answer: The state is currently using CAMP Systems for a King Air 350i and Cessna Caravan 208s. The state is currently using Veryon Tracking for Airbus H125 helicopters and general inventory for the fleet of helicopters and aircraft. The state is currently using excel documents in tracking piston aircraft both fixed wing and rotary wing
