Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Board of Chiropractic Examiners after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations amend 12 AAC 16.340 to add the Alaska Chiropractic Society to the list of board-approved nonacademic continuing education programs.

Both the November 17, 2024 public notice and the December 30, 2024 order certifying the changes state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

No technical corrections were necessary to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060.


ORDER CERTIFYING THE CHANGES TO
REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD OF CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINERS

The attached one page of regulations, dealing with updating regulations on approved nonacademic continuing education programs, is certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Board of Chiropractic Examiners adopted at its December 30, 2024 meeting, under the authority of AS 08.20.055, AS 08.20.120, and AS 08.20.170, and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

On the record, in considering public comments, the Board of Chiropractic Examiners paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.

The regulation changes described in this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180.
