A number of small ponds dot the immediate area with the nearest one being 250 yards away. The area is well inhabited by black bear, grizzly bear, moose, bison, and wolves.

The 12x20' cabin that is proposed will be constructed out of dimensional lumber using nails and screws. When it comes time to remove the structure will be dismantled and hauled away with ATVs. This process will take 2 days to complete. Once removed, the natural vegetation will take back over.
