

Alaska ABLE Accounts

Accounts increased by 15% for 2024, total of 1244 accounts

Assets increased by **26**% to \$14,962,065

Withdrawal of \$1,836,630 for disability expenses



- Current annual deposit is \$19,000 per year
- Additional \$18,810 for ABLE to Work contributions (Alaska amount)
- Total account balances limited to \$400,000 with \$100,000 or less excluded from SSI resource limits
- ABLE Age Adjustment Act will begin in January 2026, increasing age of disability onset from 26 to 46
