 - i. Ground school shall be a total of 11 hours over 1.5 days not to exceed 7 hours per day.
 - c. H125 Instructor Pilot
 - i. Ground school shall be a total of 14 hours over 2 days not to exceed 7 hours per day
 - d. H125 Maintenance Flight Procedures
 - i. Ground school will be a total of 11 hours over 1.5 days not to exceed 7 hours per day.
 - e. H125 / AS350B3 Airframe Field Maintenance for mechanics
