REQUESTED ACTIVITY: The Alaska Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Division of Mining, Land and Water (DMLW), has received a Land Use Permit application for the year round placement of a personal use dock (8'x36') for the safe moorage of a personal use fishing boat (Duckworth 28' Offshore) by the applicant. The dock would be secured to the submerged lands by two (2) 200 lbs. Danforth anchors. The proposed permit term is 5 years.
