The solicitation package for **Request for Proposals (RFP) 18-720-25 – On-demand Laboratory Services for Environmental Testing & Analysis** for the State of Alaska, Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC), Division of Water is hereby clarified or changed as follows:

1. **SEC. 1.04 PRIOR EXPERIENCE** hereby reads:

In order for offers to be considered responsive, offerors must meet one (1) or more of these requirements:

- **MINIMUM REQUIREMENT 1:** For the purposes of this RFP, the offeror shall provide documentation validating current accreditation from the National Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program (NELAP);
- **MINIMUM REQUIREMENT 2:** For the purposes of this RFP, the offeror shall supply existing approval from the DEC Contaminated Sites Program or attest to the ability to obtain approval following the award of the contract; or
- MINIMUM REQUIREMENT 3: For the purposes of this RFP, the offeror shall submit compliance
  documentation in the affirmative with current DEC-certified laboratory status and/or State of
  Washington Department of Ecology laboratory certification to analyze micro-biologicals.

An offeror's failure to meet one (1) or more of these requirements will cause their proposal to be considered non-responsive and rejected.

2. Two (2) sampling types have been added to **SEC. 3.01.02 TASK II – ANALYSIS OF CHEMISTRY (OPTIONAL)** of the solicitation. These are polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH) and total aqueous hydrocarbons (TAqH).
