**Question #1:**

Regarding Answer #1, could you clarify what is meant by "successfully train and obtain a Class A CDL"? Our training program is designed to prepare candidates for the CDL exam within four weeks and includes a road exam that provides them with the opportunity for a successful pass. However, obtaining a CDL ultimately depends on the candidate's performance and ability to meet state testing requirements. Does "successfully obtain" imply that the training provider is responsible for ensuring each candidate passes, or does it simply mean providing the necessary training and opportunity to test?

**Answer #1:**
