HF—The holder of this card is entitled to purchase subsistence hunting and fishing items with Food Stamp benefits.

In certain remote areas of Alaska subsistence hunting and fishing items may be purchased with food stamp benefits. Because you live in a community where access to stores is difficult and you may rely on hunting and fishing for subsistence, you can use your food stamp benefits to purchase hunting and fishing equipment. Eligible households are given this specially marked identification card. Please show this card at the store when buying subsistence items.

Even though some subsistence hunting and fishing items may be expensive, they cannot be purchased on credit and paid for later with food stamp benefits. Nor can they be paid for before the item is delivered.

Items that **can** be purchased with food stamp benefits include hunting and fishing equipment such as:

- Nets
- Fishing Line
- Knives
- Hooks
- Harpoons
- Rods
- Other necessary equipment

Items that **cannot** be purchased with food stamp benefits include:

- Clothing or Shelter
- Firearms
- Ammunition
- Explosives
- Equipment used for transportation (including gasoline and motor oil)
