Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Board of Game against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Board of Game after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations amend Title 5 of the Alaska Administrative Code to update requirements related to the use and taking of game in the Central and Southwest Region of the state, including hunting season, bag limit, permitting, and trapping requirements. The regulations also expand the definition of "deleterious exotic wildlife," authorize same-day use of aircraft for land-and-shoot predator removal by department employees, and update standards for department sealing of untanned animal skins.

Both the December 8, 2024 public notice and the February 11, 2025 order certifying the changes to regulations state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

We have made some technical corrections to the regulations. The corrections are incorporated into the attached copy of the regulations.
