1) A few other bids have unfortunately been rescheduled for the same day/time as the Nesbett Courthouse Clerks Office Remodel bid. To ensure there is adequate coverage from subcontractor bids and to avoid day/time conflicts, please consider extending the bid due date for this project to Friday, April 25th.

Response: Yes, the bid submittal deadline is extended to Friday, April 25, 2025 at 12 PM.

2) Please confirm that all furniture related items identified on Sheet A1-101 are OFOI.

Response: Yes, The furniture in Sheet A1-01 is Owner Furnished Owner installed (OFOI)

3) Why does Section 061000 Rough Carpentry specify that all concealed lumber and plywood must be fire-rated, given that none of these materials would be installed within fire rated assemblies according to Sheet G-002?

Response: Lumber does not need to be fire rated if not in placed in fire rated assembly. G-002 shows fire rated assemblies that are affected by work. Contractor to field verify.

4) Door schedule indicates hollow metal while the floor plan sheets/notes and specs indicate aluminum storefront. Which is correct?

Response: N101 and N143 are aluminum storefront – per schedule comments and per plan sheets.
