Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Environmental Conservation against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Department of Environmental Conservation after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations promote proper management of hazardous waste by generators, handlers, transporters, and hazardous waste management facilities in accordance with 42 U.S.C. 6921 - 6939g (Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA)), and are designed to meet federal Environmental Protection Agency standards to delegate regulation of hazardous waste from that agency to the state.

The August 13, 2023 public notice, the September 12, 2023 supplemental public notice, and the April 30, 2025 adoption order all state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

No technical corrections were necessary to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060.

 - (B) the applicable hazardous waste number designated in 40 C.F.R. Part 261 for the transported waste, and the amount received annually of each hazardous waste;
- (2) if the POTW receives, or has been notified that it will receive, wastewater that originates from remedial activities, including those undertaken under 42 U.S.C. 9601 9675 and 42 U.S.C. 6924(u) or 42 U.S.C. 6928(h), the applicant must report the following:
 - (A) the identity and description of each site or facility at which the wastewater originates;
