The purpose of this Amendment #2 is to:

- **Remove "SEC. 2.12 SUBCONTRACTORS**

Subcontractors will not be allowed." **in its entirety and replaced with:**

- **"SEC. 2.12 SUBCONTRACTORS**

Subcontractors may be used to perform work under this contract. If a bidder intends to use subcontractors, the bidder must identify in the bids the names of the subcontractors and the portions of the work the subcontractors will perform.

If a bid with subcontractors is selected, the bidder must provide the following information concerning each prospective subcontractor within five working days from the date of the state's request:

- complete name of the subcontractor;
- complete address of the subcontractor;
- type of work the subcontractor will be performing;
- percentage of work the subcontractor will be providing;
- evidence that the subcontractor holds a valid Alaska business license; and
- a written statement signed by each proposed subcontractor that clearly verifies that the subcontractor is committed to render the services required by the contract.

A bidder's failure to provide this information, within the time set, may cause the state to consider their bid non-responsive and reject it.

Note that if the subcontractor will not be performing work within Alaska, they will not be required to hold an Alaska business license."

- Provide answers to questions received.

Questions and answers

Question #1:

SEC. 2.12 does not allow subcontractors. Previous aggregate contracts allowed subcontractors and joint ventures. The ITB references subcontractors multiple times, please clarify if subcontractors will be allowed on this project?

Answer #1:

This has been corrected in this amendment. See above.

Question #2:

The bid is allowed to be submitted via email to dotnrprocurement@alaska.gov. The bid guarantee in the amount of \$5,000.00 is required to be a certified or cashier's check, will the DOT accept an emailed copy of the check?

Answer #2:

The Certified or Cashier's check must be mailed to the address listed in SEC. 1.05 of this ITB.

Question #3

Completion Dates for stockpiled aggregates are unrealistic. Example: Lot #4 Tok Locations.

- Items 4.1, 4.2, & 4.5 require 30,000 CY aggregate to be completed within 10 calendar days at three different locations.
- Items 4.3 & 4.6 require 17,500 CY of aggregate to be completed 15 day later at another two locations.
- Finally, items 4.4 & 4.7 require 17,500 CY of aggregate to be completed 16 days later at another two locations. Please consider delaying some of the delivery dates.

Answer #3:

Completion dates are estimated. The successful bidder must coordinate with the Project Manager, Henry Cole, at 907-451-2223 or via email at henry.cole@alaska.gov, if any adjustments to the scheduled completion dates are required.
