**Questions and Answers**

**Question #1**

Page 38 of the bid schedule lists King Salmon and Dutch for the As-Needed portion of the bid during the contract period (page 17 Sec. 2.33 Orders) through April 20, 2026. The barge to these locations ends in September. Will the contractor be responsible for airfreight to these locations for As-needed orders?

**Answer #1**

**Question #2**

The bid is requiring Freezing Point (diluted 1:1) with other COA tests, but this is not done routinely.

## **SEC. 2.10 EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE**

Bidders must submit written confirmation with their bid that the product offered meets the specifications set forth in this ITB. Bidders must submit the following with their bid:

1. Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS);
2. Certified independent laboratory test results from the manufacturer's initial preproduction test for the offered chemical. Test results must demonstrate clear indication that the offered chemical conforms to each specification set forth in this ITB;
3. The most recent certified independent laboratory periodic test results. Test results must demonstrate clear indication that the offered chemical conforms to each specification set forth in this ITB; and
4. Acceptance Certificate of Compliance tests from the production plant for the four (4) most recently produced lots with Product Information, (Chemical name, lot number, date of production) and Test Results, (percent by weight, Specific Gravity, pH, Flash Point, Freezing Point (diluted 1:1))

The State reserves the right to verify and approve evidence of compliance.

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The bid says we must meet the latest edition of the AMS1435 spec (version E currently), and it says the following:

### 4.2.1 Acceptance Tests

Flash point (see 3.2.1), specific gravity (see 3.2.2), and pH (see 3.2.3) are acceptance tests and shall be performed on each lot.

### 4.2.2 Periodic Tests

Freezing point (see 3.2.4), effect on aircraft metals (see 3.2.5), effect on transparent plastic (see 3.2.6), effect on painted surfaces (see 3.2.7), effect on unpainted surfaces (see 3.2.8), rinsibility (see 3.2.9), runway concrete surface scaling resistance (see 3.2.10.1), and asphalt concrete degradation resistance (see 3.2.10.2 and Appendix A; valid for deicing/anti-icing products used in Europe) are periodic tests and shall be performed on or just prior to the second anniversary of initial testing and thereafter every 4 calendar years.

### 4.2.3 Preproduction Tests

All technical requirements are preproduction tests and shall be performed prior to or on the initial shipment of product to a purchaser, when a change in ingredients and/or processing requires reapproval as in 4.4.2, and when the purchaser deems confirmatory testing to be required.

The two requirements are not in sync, please clarify.

## Modifications to Sections of the ITB

**ITB Section 2.10 Evidence of Compliance is removed in its entirety and replaced with the following language.**

Bidders must submit written confirmation with their bid that the product offered meets the specifications set forth in this ITB.

Bidders must submit the following with their bid:

1. Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS);
2. Certified independent laboratory test results from the manufacturer's initial preproduction test for the offered chemical. Test results must demonstrate clear indication that the offered chemical conforms to each specification set forth in this ITB;
3. The most recent certified independent laboratory periodic test results. Test results must demonstrate clear indication that the offered chemical conforms to each specification set forth in this ITB; and

- 4. Acceptance Certificate of Compliance tests from the production plant for the four (4) most recently produced lots with Product Information, (Chemical name, lot number, date of production) and Test Results, (percent by weight, Specific Gravity, pH, Flash Point).

The State reserves the right to verify and approve evidence of compliance.

The bidder's failure to submit the above evidence with their bid may cause the State to determine the bid non-responsive and reject the bid.

Throughout the contract term, the Contractor must submit proof of certified lab results for any lot of product within thirty (30) days of the State's written request.
