Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Board of Marital and Family Therapy against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Board of Marital and Family Therapy after the close of the public comment period.

The regulations update continuing education requirements, definitions, and other requirements to implement secs. 9 - 12, ch. 44, SLA 2024 (SCS HB 126(FIN) am S).

The certification of adoption order sets a July 1, 2025 special effective date for the regulations. Accordingly, we respectfully request that your office file the regulations on or before May 30, 2025 and use the special effective date in the filed regulations.

The March 23, 2025 public notice and the May 6, 2025 certification of adoption order both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

We have made a technical correction to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060. The correction is incorporated into the attached copy of the regulations.
