MANDATORY RETURN AMENDMENT

THIS AMENDMENT SERVES TO:

1. Issue version THREE (3) of the Bid Schedule
2. Answer potential bidder(s) questions

ITB OPENING DATE & TIME: 5/29/2025 @ 2:00 PM ALASKA TIME

- **QUESTION:** "Line Items 3, 4, 5 and 6 indicate 2.6yd dumpsters emptied 3xw - M, W, F. However at the pre-bid walkthrough 4yd dumpsters were actually on site. Can you please confirm the dumpster sizes that should be quoted and their actual frequency? I wonder if the 4yds on site are being dumped 2xw instead of 3xw?"
- **ANSWER:** The dumpsters at this location are all 4cy. The current schedule is 3xw for four of them and 2xw for the fifth. I have made the change to have all on 2xw, Version 3 schedule.
- **QUESTION:** "One of the dumpsters on line item 11 and 12 is indicated as a rental, while one is owned, however both dumpsters in place appear identical with nothing to indicate that either is owned. Please confirm if one of them is owned by the airport and will be left on site should the airport transition to a new vendor?"
- **ANSWER:** Neither is owned. I have made the change on the Version 3 bid schedule.
- **QUESTION:** "Three 4yd recycle dumpsters are listed as being at 4600 Postmark drive - line items 7, 16 and 17. We were only able to find two during the pre-bid walkthrough. Can we get confirmation of the location of the 3rd one? Two are right next to the trash compactor (line item 8)?"
- **ANSWER:** Confirmed; there are only two recycle dumpsters at this location. Version 3 Bid Schedule is updated.
- **QUESTION:** "Line item 10 indicates a summer schedule with Saturday roll off hauls. There are vendors in Anchorage which do not offer Saturday roll off pickups, but would likely still put in a bid. Is there some mechanism to qualify/disqualify bidders due to this necessity?"
- **ANSWER:** Bidders will be held to the scope and terms of the contract. Please bid as requested.

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- **QUESTION:** *“Line items with on call services - 8, 17, 18, 19, 20, and 21 do not indicate a number of estimated pickups per year. Should the cost of one empty be used under the monthly service charge column?”*
- **ANSWER:** Yes, please use one (1) empty.

- **QUESTION:** *“Line items with on call services - 14, 15 and 16 indicate 14 empties per year. For the value in the monthly service charge column, should we put the cost of one empty under the column or multiply one empty by 14 and divide that number by 12 to estimate the monthly cost?”*
- **ANSWER:** Enter the cost of one (1) empty to remain in line with the other call-in services referenced above.

- **QUESTION:** *“Kulis Fire Station - line item 12 indicates a 2.6yd dumpster. A 4yd dumpster was on site during the pre-bid walkthrough. Which should this be bid as?”*
- **ANSWER:** A 4yd dumpster is indicated on line item 12.

- **QUESTION:** *“Line items 18 and 19, on call recycle dumpsters for the south terminal, were not able to be found during the pre-bid meeting. Please confirm that these containers are still on site being used, and the location of them?”*
- **ANSWER:** The containers are still on-site and being used. They are located in the recyclables room and are rolled out to the dock (near the 30cy roll off compactor) for pick-up when called in for service.

- **QUESTION:** *“From the bid: “The state understands that Regulatory Cost Charge and Fuel surcharges are in effect for each vendor.” However we do not have any fuel surcharge. Other vendors may charge them anywhere from 2-4%. Is there a good way to indicate that our proposal will not have an additional fuel surcharge applying on top of the rates from the bid schedule? In a close bid it could be the difference between one vendor or another?”*
- **ANSWER:** No, bid as requested.

Please use **VERSION THREE (3) Bid Schedule** attached to this Amendment Four (4), discard all other versions of the bid schedule.
