CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION LAS 5204

The State of Alaska, acting by and through the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Mining, Land and Water, 550 W. 7th Ave, Suite 1020, Anchorage, AK 99501-3562, hereinafter referred to as the grantor, under AS 46.15, the Alaska Water Use Act, and the regulations adopted under it, grants to:

The right to the following use of water:

SOURCE: Two Drilled Well
QUANTITY: 750,000 Gallons / Day
PERIOD: January 1st through December 31st
USE: Public Water Supply

With a PRIORITY DATE of December 16, 1985.

The location of this water source:

Two drilled wells, 236 and 240 feet deep, located within Lot 7, Block 2 of Wasilla Woods Subdivision, according to the official plat thereof, filed under Plat No. 71-25, Palmer Recording District, Third Judicial District, State of Alaska.

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The location to which this water right is appurtenant:

Within the legal boundaries of the City of Wasilla.

The holder of this Certificate of Appropriation shall:

1. Follow acceptable engineering standards in exercising the water right granted by this permit and certificate.
2. Except for claims or losses arising from negligence of the State, defend and indemnify the State against and hold it harmless from any and all claims, demands, legal actions, loss, liability, and expense for injury to or death of persons and damages to or loss of property arising out of or connected with the exercise of the water right granted by this permit and certificate.
3. Comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and conditions.
4. Notify the grantor of any change of address, transfer of any real property identified in this permit and certificate, or proposed change in the water appropriation.
5. If the grantor determines that this appropriation unduly affects a prior appropriator's ability to obtain water in accordance with his or her permit or certificate, this appropriation may be amended or water use may be curtailed until the prior appropriator can again obtain water under his or her prior right. Those individuals within the same area that do not have water rights may also be required to curtail taking water.
6. Continue to monitor water use monthly and submit monthly water use reports annually to dnr.water.reports@alaska.gov.
7. Notify the Division of any major well maintenance work performed and submit a report to this office within 45 days of completion that includes testing data, maintenance results, date when the well was shut down and restarted, static water level, name of contractor who performed the work and the dates of work.
8. Permanent decommissioning of any well must be in compliance with requirements of 18 AAC 80.015(e) and 11 AAC 93.140. Abandonment report shall be submitted to this office and DEC within 45 days of completion.
9. Comply with 18 AAC 80 and maintain direct contact with the ADEC-Drinking Water point-of-contact for the region, Charity Bare, at charity.bare@alaska.gov, where applicable.
10. Per 11 AAC 05.260(e), an annual administrative service fee shall be assessed on this appropriation of water.

This water right is granted subject to the pertinent statutory provisions in AS 46.15 and Administrative Regulations in 11 AAC 93.

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This Certificate of Appropriation is issued by authority of AS 46.15.080, AS 46.15.120, 11 AAC 93.120, and 11 AAC 93.130 on April 24, 2025.

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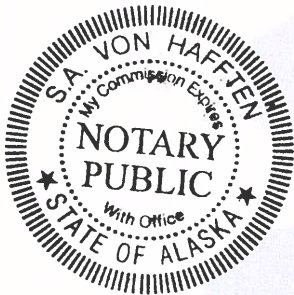
