Dear Lieutenant Governor Dahlstrom:

The Department of Law has reviewed the attached regulations of the Department of Environmental Conservation against the statutory standards of the Administrative Procedure Act. Based upon our review, we find no legal problems. This letter constitutes the written statement of approval under AS 44.62.060(b) and (c) that authorizes your office to file the attached regulations. The regulations were adopted by the Department of Environmental Conservation after the close of the public comment period.

In response to concerns from the State Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers, and Land Surveyors regarding the former terms "supervise construction" and "construction supervision" in the wastewater disposal regulations, and how the definition of those terms could be interpreted to impact the scope of a registered engineer's responsibilities, the regulations now set out a definition of "inspect construction" and "construction inspection," that more tightly express a registered engineer's function, and make conforming amendments across the wastewater disposal regulations. 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The December 1, 2024 public notice and the July 10, 2025 order adopting changes both state that this action is not expected to require an increased appropriation. Therefore, a fiscal note under AS 44.62.060 is not required.

We have made a technical correction to conform the regulations in accordance with AS 44.62.060. The correction is incorporated into the attached copy of the regulations.

ORDER ADOPTING CHANGES TO REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

The attached four pages of regulations, dealing with the term "Construction Inspection", are adopted and certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Department of Environmental Conservation adopts under the authority of AS 44.46.020; AS 44.46.025; AS 46.03.020; AS 46.03.050; AS 46.03.100; AS 46.03.110; and AS 46.03.710 and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

In considering public comments, the Department of Environmental Conservation paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken. The Department of Environmental Conservation also gave special attention to alternate practical methods in this regulatory action as required by AS 46.03.024.

The regulation changes adopted under this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor as provided in AS 44.62.180.
