**E-1 Aggregate Dyea Road in Skagway – Federally Funded**

**This is an informational amendment and is not a mandatory return amendment.**

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**The purpose of this amendment is to:**

- Answer three questions clarifying material sources and delivery.

**QUESTION:**

Are there any Department of Transportation & Public Facilities permitted material sites available?

**ANSWER:**

There are no Department of Transportation and Public Facilities permitted material sites in Skagway or Haines.

**QUESTION:**

It appears Jeff Hamilton controls the only available quarry accessible from Skagway, is there an issue with the quality of that source, or Jeff's ability to produce?

**ANSWER:**

The Department of Transportation and Public Facilities will not know the details of any potential contractor unless a bid is submitted by that contractor.

Note: Subcontracting is allowable under this ITB if this allows potential contractors to create a more cost-effective bid.

E-1 AGGREGATE DYEA ROAD IN SKAGWAY -FEDERALLY FUNDED

**QUESTION:**

Am I correct assuming the Department anticipates barging aggregate from some other location to SGY to fill this need?

**ANSWER:**

The Department of Transportation and Public Facilities will not know the details or necessity of aggregate delivery until the contract is awarded. Depending on the location of the winning contractor it may be necessary to barge the aggregate to the delivery site.

Per ITB 2526S011 under SEC. 2.15 F.O.B. POINT:

The contractor will be required to prepare the items for shipping and to ship them to the ultimate destination specified in the State's order. Ownership of and title to the ordered items remains with the contractor until the items have been delivered to their final destination and are accepted by the State. **The costs of all shipping and delivery must be included in the bid price.**

Per ITB 2526S011 under SEC. 2.16 Delivery:

Bid price must include freight to the final destination. The contractor shall determine the type of vehicle used for all deliveries.

Therefore, any shipping costs or methods will be included in a bidder's submission and are the responsibility of the bidder.
