Introduction:

The Department of Public Safety (DPS), Division of Administrative Services, is requesting information on available hangar space for State owned aircraft located in Tok, Delta Junction, and Aniak Alaska. The space must meet the following requirements and be located within the city limits:

- o Between 2,500 and 3,600 square feet in size (+/-), usable hangar dimensions
- o AVGAS tank is preferred, not mandatory.
- Tug is preferred, not mandatory
- Restroom is preferred, not mandatory
- o Two exterior parking spaces w/ optional energized head bolt heaters outlets
- Construction complying with required Building and Fire Codes
- Hangar door shall be of adequate dimensions to accommodate the required aircraft or equipment, with a desired opening of 55 feet wide by 18 feet high. Equivalent functional configurations that meet operational requirements will be considered. The state shall determine if submitted dimensions are suitable for required aircraft.

Response Information:

If you are interested in providing hangar space to the State in Tok, Delta Junction, or Aniak, Alaska, respond in writing no later than **September 15, 2025.**

Responses must indicate location and compliance with the items below and include a name and contact information:

- Square Footage of proposed facility and floor-plans
- Location of building(s) (physical address and legal description)
- Number of parking spaces available (to accommodate staff and SOA owned vehicles)
- Estimated date unit(s) could be ready for State occupancy
- Type of connectivity available to the space including cellphone providers
- Electrical services available in the space including lighting and available outlets.

This RFI does not obligate the State to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP), award a lease contract, or pay any costs incurred in the preparation of a response to this RFI. Do not submit price/costs with your response, a Notice of Award for space will not be made as a direct result of this RFI. Contact information will be kept on file for any potential future related RFP solicitations under AS 36.30, Alaska State Procurement Code.

This RFI does not extend any rights to prospective vendors or obligate the state to conduct a solicitation or purchase any goods or services. Nor will the state be financially responsible for any cost associated with the preparation of any response for the requested information. This RFI is issued for the sole purpose of obtaining information as described in this notice. However, the information obtained from this request may be used to prepare a purchase, contract, or solicitation in the future.
