

Please describe your proposed amendment and attach all required forms from the APMA application.

Amendment to add construction of Pioneer trail from existing road on ADL 562589 to ADL 563182. Trail to be built to access upper bench claims where no access has existed. Starting from the existing road up Falls Creek, the pioneer road will traverse the hillside with apx. 900 ft in elevation gain. This new trail will allow access by equipment and ATVs to prospect potential new deposits previously worked by hydraulic miners in the early 1900's. If workable ground is located, then steps to build more reliable access will be taken.




