The changes/clarifications directed by this Addendum #3 are described on this 1 (one) page.


## **Questions/Answers:**


- 1. At the walk through there was a mock-up of the clerk's counter, on it a paint sample was present that is different than the current walls. What is the desired paint color? Answer: paint color is Fuller O'Brien "It's A Cream" OW 134.
- 2. The wall we are extending in the clerk's office is 5" thick overall. The drawings reference 5-1/2" metal studs plus sheetrock. (B4A-104) This is too thick and 5-1/2" metal studs are unusual. Answer: To match existing wall thickness, use a 3 5/8" metal studs and (1) layer of 5/8" gypsum board on each side to achieve the 5" thick wall.
- 3. Is there a room or space on the 2nd floor to store materials and work from? On the 1st floor would even work. Answer: ACS does not currently have any extra storage space in the facility.
- 4. A3/A-104 references 3/4" solid surface material. This item comes in 1/2" thicknesses, can we use additional plywood to make up the difference? Answer: Yes, this is approved.
- 5. Per onsite discussion, Putting the ballistic shielding on the front of the benches and overlay with matching wood panels? Answer: Please bid per the drawings attached to the ITB.
- 6. C1/A105 shows a dashed line. A1/A105 does not show a dashed line. The legend does not indicate what the dashed line is for. Please advise what the dashed line is for and if it should also be applied to A1/A105. Answer: The dashed line indicates the location of the ballistic shielding installation. The drawing has been revised to show it applying to A1/A-105 (attached).
- 7. There is only one wall type shown W01 pointing to a 1'7 ½" extension at the COC waiting. B4/A-104 defines W01 as 5 1/2" metal stud. The wall that we need to connect to is 5". Can we use wood studs on this project so the walls plane out smooth? Answer: The wall extensions should use 3 5/8" metal studs with 5/8" gypsum board on both sides to achieve the 5" thickness.
- 8. Will the elevator be in-service and available for our use? Answer: yes.
- 9. 1/M501 Requesting welding details. Answer: 3/16 Fillet weld 1" long on each angle leg.


