DOUGLAS ISLAND BUILDING SNOW REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL**

This amendment is informational and is not a mandatory return amendment.

The purpose of this amendment is to:

- Provide answers to questions received from an interested party, and to clarify the work to be performed.

Question 1

How often does the snow have to be hauled off site.

Answer

Per Section 2.01 Scope of Work/Snow Removal and Disposal Services states:

Snow Removal and Disposal Services

Snow removal services will be performed when a snow accumulation of no greater than 2" is present in this parking area, or at the direction of the Project Manager or Designee.

As the snow will need to be removed from the parking area with each occurrence, it will need to be disposed of offsite with each occurrence. There is no room at this facility to store snow, therefore removal and disposal will be necessary at each occurrence.

Question 2

Is there a little wiggle room for timing?

Answer

Per Section 2.01 Scope of Work/Snow Removal and Disposal Services states:

Snow Removal and Disposal Services

Snow removal services will be performed and completed prior to 7:00 am Monday through Friday excluding State holidays, or as needed at the direction of the Project Manager or Designee.

The purpose of the 7:00 am removal requirement is to have the parking lot cleared prior to the arrival of State employees and persons conducting State business at the facility. Therefore, this requirement is nonnegotiable.
