RE: Multi-Year 2025-2030 Hardrock Exploration & Reclamation #2955 Hardrock Exploration Fairbanks Mining District FM T1S R2W Section 32 FM T1N R3W Sections 13, 24, & 25

In accordance with State Regulation 11 AAC 86.800 the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, may issue Plan of Operations for a specified term, provided the application meets the requirements. This office has reviewed and adjudicated your proposed plans and has issued a Plan of Operations for the activities described that will remain in effect until 110/15/2030, unless sooner revoked at will or for cause.

You are advised further APMA's involving this project will not be required to be submitted during the time frame of your permit, unless proposed changes occur. Any changes or modifications to your original activity <u>must be</u> submitted in writing and <u>approved in advance</u> before the commencement of such activity.

Although this office intends to conduct annual field assistance visits to ensure your activity conforms to the plans submitted, please note, by December 31st of each year your permit is in effect, you are required to submit the following:

- 1. A 2025 Reclamation Statement detailing the reclamation actions taken during that mining season. This statement serves as the annual report required under 11 AAC 97.320(a).
- 2. A Reclamation Plan form for the 2026 season (Use the Reclamation/Signature Page of the APMA).
- 3. A completed 2026 Bond Renewal form for the coming season. Federal miners must submit a Bond Renewal Form signed by BLM.
- 4. If requesting bond release for reclaimed acres, please provide a notarized Application for Release of Reclamation Bond. You must include photographs or video of the completed reclamation work; If you are a BLM operator, a copy of the BLM's reclamation approval letter.

These items will be distributed annually to those agencies on the APMA distribution listing. Be advised that the issuance of any authorization by the Division of Mining, Land & Water does not relieve you of the responsibility of securing other permits required by federal, state, or local governmental agencies.
