Questions submitted by potential offerors and answers from the state:

Question 1: Are electronic signatures acceptable on submittal forms, or must they be handwritten and scanned?
<u>Answer:</u> Electronic signatures are acceptable.
Question 2: Is there a preferred format for monthly case reporting, or can mediators propose a reporting template for approval?
<u>Answer:</u> The Department of Health may have guidance on what it requires based on its reporting needs, but until identified, the mediator can propose its own reporting template.
