City of Kake – Alaska Recreational Trails Program (RTP)

The City of Kake is applying for funding through the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation's Recreational Trails Program (RTP).

Project Description:

The City proposes to restore an existing community trail, create a wildlife-viewing area, and conduct a feasibility study for a pedestrian bridge and waterfront viewing area. The project will improve trail safety, expand outdoor recreation opportunities, and enhance the community's access to local natural resources and scenic spaces.

Location:

Existing community trail and adjacent waterfront area within the City of Kake, Alaska.

Project Timeline:

January 2026 – December 2026
