DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME REGULATORY REVISIONS

Notice of Public Scoping Under Administrative Order 360 for possible Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) Regulation Changes in Title 5, Chapter 93 regarding salmon use and salmon fishery associations.

Background. In response to Administrative Order 360, ADF&G is soliciting written and oral comments from affected industries, community organizations, and the general public regarding regulations and materials incorporated by reference in 5 AAC 93.310 – .400.

ADF&G is undertaking this solicitation process to ask the public for ideas, suggestions, and input before the department drafts or proposes any specific regulation amendments or repeals for public review.

The ADF&G is particularly interested in specific ideas for regulatory change that may:

- clarify existing regulatory obligations;
- reduce costs for the public, industry, or government;
- improve or streamline procedures, application requirements, and review processes, for example reducing the time required to apply for a license, permit, or benefit;
- reduce administrative burdens;
- streamline permitting procedures;
- improve communication procedures;
- provide greater transparency with respect to standards, decision-making, and rationales for application processing; or
- clarify interagency roles.

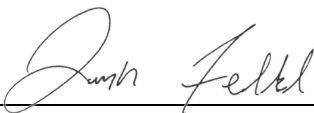
