Appendix P: Finding of Emergency and Adoption Order

FINDING OF EMERGENCY

The Department of Labor and Workforce Development, Division of Employment and Training Services, finds that an emergency exists and that the attached regulation is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or general welfare. The facts constituting the emergency include the following:

Currently, 8 AAC 85.351, Able and Available for Suitable Work: Registration for Work, unless deferred, requires claimants to register for work with AlaskaJobs and submit either one or two work search activities for each week filed, depending on their location.

Federal civilian employees who are currently furloughed due to the federal government shutdown, and who are filing for Alaska unemployment insurance benefits, are still job attached but must meet the eligibility requirements of 85.351. This may create a conflict of interest for federal employees because outside employment cannot conflict with the employee's official duties under federal law.

This emergency regulation will defer the requirements of registration and job search for federal civilian employees filing for unemployment insurance benefits during furlough periods.

ADOPTION ORDER

Under the authority of AS 23.20.045, the attached regulation changes are therefore adopted as an emergency regulation to take effect immediately upon filing by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180(3) and any other applicable authority.

This action is not expected to require increased appropriations.

Register 256, January 2025 LABOR AND WORKFORCE DEV.

8 AAC 85.351 (g) is amended to read:

- (g) The director may defer registration for work for a claimant who is
- (1) temporarily unemployed with a definite date to return to full-time work within 45 days after the date the claimant files the initial claim;
 - (2) unemployed due to a labor dispute;
- (3) traveling immediately following the filing of the initial claim, for the purpose of relocating outside of this state; upon arrival in the new area of residence, the claimant shall register for work as required in (a) of this section;
 - (4) repealed 3/4/2006;
- (5) normally hired through a trade union, if the union furnishes information when requested by the director to verify the claimant's current membership and eligibility for dispatch;
 - (6) repealed 3/4/2006;
 - (7) repealed 3/4/2006;
 - (8) under an approved waiver of availability under AS 23.20.378 or 23.20.382.
- (9) a furloughed federal employee out of work as a result of a federal government shutdown.
