Application for Third Party Use of Pogo Mine Road

Description of the Project Area

The SAM Alaska Project is located in the Fairbanks Mining District between Fairbanks and Delta Junction, approximately 20 miles north of the Richardson Highway in the hills south of the Salcha River (Figure 1). Most of the property lies within the Fairbanks North Star Borough (FNSB). Approximately 65% of the property is within the Tanana Valley State Forest. The Trans-Alaska Pipeline System (TAPS) oil pipeline and a Golden Valley Electric Association (GVEA) transmission line are to the west of the project area. The project area is entirely comprised of State of Alaska mining claims (Figure 2).

Description of Activity


A State of Alaska Application for Permits to Mine in Alaska (APMA #9882) packet for reclamation activities at the SAM Project was granted by ADNR on September 26, 2025. The authorization expires December 31, 2026. SAM ALASKA LLC plans to conduct reclamation activities at the SAM Project between September 2025 and December 2026 as needed - details are included in the 2025 APMA 9882 application.


This application requests the use of the Pogo Access Road to approximately 12.5 miles inside the gate in order to transport reclamation equipment to the SAM Ridge Route access point. Equipment will be transported to and from the takeout point at approximately 12.5 mile (Figure 4). The following equipment has been proposed to be used:


- John Deere 450 Dozer

- Four (4) ATV/UTVs with pull behind trailers




