RFI 26-004 DCHS – THIRD PARTY LIABILITY (TPL) CONTRACTOR SERVICES AMENDMENT #1

This document is to answer questions submitted by potential respondents to this RFI. It also provides an extension, so potential respondents have opportunity to review questions and answers before submitting their responses.

Question 1: What is the anticipated contract value for this service?

Answer 1: Contract value at this time is unknown; making a determination of cost is part of the purpose of the RFI. Reference RFI 26-004, Introduction: "This Request for Information (RFI) is issued solely for information and planning purposes. Responses will assist the State in refining requirements, evaluating available solutions, and determining the feasibility of future procurement" and Response Information, #6: "An itemized, estimated cost range for an eight-year contract to include cost per service provided. State any assumptions and inclusions/exclusions."

Question 2: Is there a timeline in pursuing the project?

Answer 2: The current contract expires June 30, 2027, and any continued services will require a new solicitation. Solicitation timelines run to roughly six (6) months. That said, at this stage this timeline is an estimate and subject to change. There also is no guarantee that this RFI will result in a solicitation.

Question 3: Is there a current vendor providing this service or is it a new requirement? If there is a current vendor, could you please provide the current contract documents/information?

Answer 3: There is a current vendor performing services under State of Alaska Contract 0619-158 HMS R & R - Cost Avoidance and Post Payment Recovery. Parties wishing to access copies of this contract must contact the procurement officer listed on the RFI via dedicated email and specify the documents desired.
