For the application for LAS 32458, I have a couple quick questions:

- 1. The daily rate was not included in the application. Will the water right be matching the existing temporary authorization, TWUA A2024-146, which has 200,000 GPD? The yearly amount is comparable between the TWUA and water right application.
- 2. The TWUA and Fish Habitat Permit for this source says withdrawals are from open water only. The water right application requests year round. Are you requesting ice or liquid water under ice (if possible) or did you want the water right to match the existing temporary authorization?
