### **Questions submitted by potential offerors and answers from the state:**

**Question 1:** Are the sidewalks on the north side included in ITEM 2?

**Answer:** Concrete sidewalks are around the entrance of the boardwalk and in front of the parking stalls and toilet area in the north parking lot

---

**Question 2:** It appears the existing sidewalks are packed currently and have not been maintained. Will they be cleared before our contract begins?

**Answer:** The sidewalks will NOT be maintained before the contract begins.

---

**Question 3:** ITEM 2 is vague in the requirement for Sand and Ice Melt placement. Is the intent to sand/Ice Melt immediately after clearing snow one time? Or is the Sand/Ice Melt supposed to be maintained as needed until another call out is made for shoveling? ITEM 2:

**Answer:** When the sidewalks are icy and dangerous for walking, then the ice melt and sanding is needed. This could be after freezing rain and not just after it snows.

**Question 4:** ITEM 1: I am trying to determine the risk on this item. If it snows 12 inches, do we get called out twice for this? If we get called out for six (6) inches, that is a different work effort as compared to 12 inches. That is why I am asking.

**Answer:** The Billing accounts for variation in snow fall with each visit billed by each 12" of snowfall for plowing and shoveling. So basic rate if for 1-12", and the rate is 2x if 13-24", the rate is 3x if 24-36" and so on.
