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Questions submitted by potential bidders and answers from the State:

Question 1:

By stating no salt shall be used what material is expected to be used? All ice melt material contains salt of some chemical formula. Sand is not an ice melt compound so we are a little confused what this expectation is.

Answer:

This is reasonably contradictory. This section is now updated provide increased clarity. See change below.

Question 2:

Section 2.01 Scope of Work and Specifications, Paragraph 3 3. "Contractor to apply ice melting compound on sidewalks and entrance areas on an "as needed" basis for employees and public safety". Who determines the as needed basis here? Also how is that going to be billed we do not see a bid tab for sanding or adding traction aid

to the sidewalk?

Answer: *The Project Director will determine when or if additional traction material is required. This may be billed if necessary as "sidewalk clearing cost" if it is stand alone (not in combination with sanding the parking lot).*

Changes to the ITB:

Change 1:

SEC 2.01 Scope of Work and Specifications, Paragraph 3 is now changed to:

Contractor to apply traction assisting compound on sidewalks and entrance areas on an "as needed" basis for employees and public safety. Traction assisting compound must be environmentally safe and shall not be harmful to grass, sidewalk material, or interior carpet. Specifications of traction assisting compound to be provided with the bid. Sand preferred - no coarse gravel. No salt shall be used
