**Subject:** FY25 Historic Preservation Certified Local Government (CLG) Grant Applications

The **Office of History and Archaeology (OHA)** announces that applications are now being accepted from **Certified Local Governments (CLGs)** for **60/40 matching grant projects** funded through the **National Park Service Historic Preservation Fund (HPF)**. All funded projects must be completed by **September 15, 2027**.

#### Funding Details:

- Ten percent of Alaska's annual Historic Preservation Fund allocation is designated for CLG projects.
- Eligible applicants include local governments with approved historic preservation commissions and CLG designation.
- Applications are reviewed by the Alaska Historical Commission and grants are administered by OHA.
- Grants are awarded on a competitive basis, require matching funds and must support historic preservation efforts.
- **Estimated Funding Available:** \$174,000
- **Federal Share Request:** Minimum \$10,000; Maximum \$50,000

#### Application Deadline:

Applications must be received by **12:00 p.m. (noon) on Friday, March 20, 2026**.
