Questions submitted by potential applicants and answers from the Trust:

Question 1: Can we see a list of organizations who have previously applied for a mini-grant through these two programs?

Answer: In FY25 and FY26 to date, over 220 organizations applied for a mini-grant through these two programs. A complete alphabetized list starts on page 4 of this amendment.

Question 2: For the Grants Management Platform requirement of the grantee, would the Trust be open to maintaining their existing account for the current BH & DD Mini Grant Program application platform, and allow / expand back-end permissions to the grantee?

Answer: The successful grantee will be responsible for maintaining their own grants management platform independent of any such platform the Trust has maintained in the past.

Question 3: Would the Trust expect “unused” Administrative Costs (at the end of each fiscal year) to be returned to the Trust or reallocated to the subsequent fiscal year’s budget? This question comes from our understanding that “unused” grant funds are returned to the Trust each year alongside annual reporting, so we are wondering if that would now extend to the admin costs as well.

Answer: The grant is for the entire program budget, inclusive of administrative costs. Any unused grant funds must be returned to the Trust each year alongside annual reporting. Administrative costs are not treated any differently.

Changes to the RFP:

Change 1: In Section 3.01 Eligibility on page 7 of the RFP, remove the second paragraph and replace it with:

Eligible applicants include nonprofit organizations; political subdivisions of the state such as municipalities, cities, organized boroughs, and Regional Educational Attendance Areas; Alaska Native Tribes; and for-profit entities. An individual is not eligible to receive a grant.

Change 2: In Section 3.06 Proposal Costs and Content on page 8 of the RFP, remove the second paragraph and replace it with:

This RFP is for a one-year period, beginning July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, with four (4) 1-year renewal options. All renewal options will be at the sole discretion of the Trust. The annual decision to continue funding for the subsequent year(s) of the five-year grant cycle is based on the following general conditions:

Change 3: In instruction 4 of Attachment 3 Budget Proposal, correct the typo from “relevan” to “relevant”.

Change 4: Remove Section 4.02 Eligibility Criteria on pages 11 and 12 and replace it with the following:

Applicants must be eligible per 20 AAC 40.205. Proposals that fail to demonstrate eligibility in one of the ways below will be eliminated from consideration.
