4. Questions or comments that were received by the Procurement Manager from potential Bidders:

- a. *Can we hang a garbage shoot off the fifth floor fire escape stairs to a dumpster, truck, or staging area in the parking spaces near the bottom of the stairs for disposal of materials?*

Response: Yes, the Successful Bidder may use the stairwell and spaces around the base of the stairwells to secure a garbage shoot at the top of the stairwells to stage materials for disposal, however, the Successful Bidder must maintain emergency access to the fire escape stairwell and all the building exits on the stairwells during the entire project. The Agency may have other construction projects that may overlap certain areas of the parking lot access, the Agency's Project Director will coordinate overlapping projects to ensure accessibility for the projects that will be occurring simultaneously.

- b. *Can we perform the work outside of normal business hours?*

Response: Yes, the Agency will allow the Successful Bidder to perform Work outside of normal business hours, the Successful Bidder must coordinate access to the Capitol outside of normal business hours with the Agency's Project Director.
