Questions submitted by potential applicants and answers from the Trust:

Question 1: Will the Trust be requiring an official independent financial audit of the grantee if the grantee is a for-profit entity?

According to our understanding of AK Legislation Chapter 45 - Grant Administration, a for-profit entity is not included in entities subject to a single audit submitted to the State under this section. The RFP states "...successful applicants will be issued a Grant Agreement. This formal agreement will contain specific performance and reporting requirements consistent with Trust policy and procedure." and we are seeking clarification of any financial audit requirements that may be included in the Trust's reporting requirements not already laid out in the RFP reporting section(s).

Answer: The Trust does not require an audit to be considered for Trust grants. However, Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority funds are state financial assistance and subject to state single audit requirements under 2 AAC 45.
