The following question was received regarding RFP 18-820-26 for Tongass Narrows Sampling for the State of Alaska, Department of Environmental Conservation, Division of Water. The State's response is provided below.

Question:

After reviewing the addenda, I am still unclear on this question:

In the scheduling table, when a sample event has a date range, are samples to be collected every day during the range, or only one set of samples to be collected on any day within that date range?

State's Response:

"If there is a date range (denoted by the word 'to'), then one sample event needs to happen sometime during that date range. If MST samples are not being collected, there is more flexibility with when the sample is collected. For the MST sampling, we are relying on established flights and the availability of a courier in Seattle. For example, from the schedule for sample event 3 (underlined in red), the samples could be collected on either 5/4/26 or 5/6/26. For sample event 7 (underlined in blue), the samples don't include MST sampling, so they could be collected during the date range, on 7/5/26, 7/6/26, or 7/7/26."
